ARTICLE OF CLOTHING	APPROVED COLOR(S)	NOTES
Pants	Khaki or Navy Blue	Plain, no cargos, capris or leggings
Shorts	Khaki or Navy Blue	<b>ALL GRADES:</b> Plain, no cargo shorts  All shorts must be long enough to cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the thigh.
Skirts: <i>A-line, knife, kick, box pleated</i>  Skorts: <i>Kilt type (flap opening)</i>  Jumpers	Khaki, Navy Blue, Royal Plaid #49	All skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be long enough to cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the thigh.  <i>Leggings, tights, or bike shorts <b>must be worn</b> with skirts and skorts with loose undershorts.</i>  <i>Please keep in mind that napping children need to ensure they are modest while laying down.</i>
Shirts: <i>Polo or Oxford, long or short sleeves, Peter Pan collar</i>  <i>School T-Shirts</i>	White, Gold, Forest Green, Maroon, Navy Blue  Any color School T-Shirt	Grades 2nd and above must be worn tucked in
Undershirts: <i>long or short sleeved</i>	White or Black	Worn under approved shirts
Sweatshirts	White or Navy Blue	
Belts: <i>mandatory for 2nd-7th Grades</i>	Khaki, Brown, Black, Navy Blue	Plain (no designs)
Hair accessories	Any color	Small, plain with no beads or sequins or distracting features
Jewelry	Gold or silver	Only 1 pair of earrings allowed, maximum 2" in length No extremes in necklaces or bracelets
Socks	Khaki, White, Navy Blue	Required for all grades
Tights	Navy Blue, White	
Shoes: <i>athletic, lace-up, slip on, or loafer</i>	Any Color	No shoes containing cartoon or toy figures, rollers, or lights. No boots, high heeled shoes, cleats or sandals. No open toe shoes.  Grades K3-K5: Velcro closure shoes are strongly recommended.
Sweaters/Vests: <i>button-up or zipper</i>	Navy Blue	Plain or with school logo. May be worn in class.
Windbreakers or fleece jackets	Any Color	
Outer Jackets/Coats	Any Color	NO trench coats.
Hats/Caps/Hoods		May be worn during cold weather, but NOT indoors
<b>FRIDAY CLOTHING</b>	School T-Shirts, Christian T-shirts and blue jeans allowed	No leggings may be worn as pants.
